G.S.R. 202.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Directorate of Training (Vocational Training Programme for Women) Group 'C' Technical Post Recruitment Rules, 1987 and the Directorate of Training (Vocational Training Programme for Women) Group 'D' Non-Gazetted (Ministerial & Non-Ministerial) post Recruitment Rules, 1995 in so far as they relate to the posts of Workshop Attendant, Store Attendant and Library Attendant under Women's Vocational Training Programme, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the General Central Service Group 'C' Non-Gazetted technical posts in the workmen's unit as fixed by the Central Government under the "Vocational Training Programme for Women" Scheme of the Directorate General of Employment and Training, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—

(1) These rules may be called the Directorate of Training (Vocational Training Programme for Women) Group 'C'—Technical Posts Recruitment Rules, 1999.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

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2. Number of posts, classification and scales of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No Person —

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Whether the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reason to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons,

6. Savings.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and

other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

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stage of selection the competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
