As you may be aware, the Directorate General of Training (DGT), under the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Government of India, has developed a digital learning platform—BHARATSKILLS (https://bharatskills.gov.in), to strengthen digital learning across the skilling ecosystem. As of mid-2025, it has served millions—over 7.3 million unique users with 43 million+ hits, reflecting its citizen-centric adoption.

- Launched in October 2019, Bharatskills (https://bharatskills.gov.in) is a free, mobile-responsive, bilingual (Hindi and English) platform that provides seamless access to high-quality digital learning resources for students enrolled under the Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) and Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS), and the instructors. It supports self-paced, independent learning without requiring any login or registration, thereby ensuring data privacy and accessibility even on low-bandwidth networks. The platform includes NSQF-aligned curriculum, e-books, question banks, mock tests, practice papers, and videos, and is currently available in 13 languages.
- In recognition of its contribution to citizen-centric service delivery, Bharatskills received the Silver Award at the 25th National Awards for e-Governance held on 26th November 2022, organized by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances, Government of India.
- 4. BharatSkills platform also features a growing repository of self-paced online courses from reputed industry partners such as IBM, Microsoft, Cisco, Amazon Web Services (AWS), Quest Alliance, and the Wadhwani Foundation. Students can earn certificates and badges from these industry-partnered courses. In addition, interactive content for the Employability Skills modules has been made available, and a digital financial literacy application has recently been introduced to enhance learner engagement.
- It is requested to kindly disseminate the details of the Bharatskills platform and encourage trainers and students to explore and utilize the platform for continuous learning and upskilling. A poster has also been designed and attached for dissemination and display on the notice boards and classrooms of the institute to create wider awareness about the BharatSkills platform.
