Sub: Sanction for Release of an amount of Rs. 80.00 Lakh (Rs. 40 Lakh each) to the Industry Cluster (IC) (i) Rai Industries Association and (ii) Integrated Association of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises of India through Haryana State Directorate as 40% advance (against maximum possible grant-in-aid of Rs one crore) on signing of tripartite grant agreement for IAI under Result Area 4 (Improved and Broadened Apprenticeship Training) of World Bank assisted project "Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE)" during the FY 2021-22- regarding-

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction on the behalf of President of India for the release of funds for **Rs. 80.00 Lakh (Rs. 40 Lakh each)** as 40% advance on signing of tri-partite agreement under Result Area 4 (Improved and Broadened Apprenticeship Training) of World Bank assisted STRIVE project to the Industry Cluster (i) Rai Industries Association and (ii) Integrated Association of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises of India through Haryana State Directorate during the FY 2021-22-.

2. The Grants-In-Aid is being released subjected to the following terms conditions:

- (i) The Grant-In-Aid is to be utilized only for the purpose for which it is released under Result Area 4 as directed in the Operations Manual (OM) of STRIVE through State Apprenticeship Monitoring Cell (SAMC). No portion of the fund is to be spent under any other purpose.
- (ii) Utilization Certificate in form 12C/12A of GFR of 2017 in duplicate be kindly furnished immediately on utilization of such fund.
- (iii) The sanctioned fund stated at para-1/above must be utilized before closure of STRIVE project or as earlier as per notification and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
- (iv) Unspent amount, if any will be adjusted against future sanction in a manner as clearly stated in Tripartite Grant Agreement.
- (v) The conditions mentioned in the tripartite grant agreement must be adhered to during project implementation.
- (vi) All documents of the project related to expenditures of grant-in-aid must be retained by the State Government/Industry Cluster till project closure for post review by World Bank, DGT and Auditors.
- (vii) IC must share the agreed documents with State Government as per Disclosure Management Framework to be disclosed on the website of SPIU/DGT.
- (viii) The accounts of all grantee institution or organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act, 1971, and audit by NPIU/SPIU either by its own or through

- any agency, whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so. All other terms and conditions for release of funds for the project will remain unchanged.
- (ix) Being first reference of the implementing agency ie Industry for cluster under RA 4, or UC is pending for will be due in next FY.

3. The Grant is Non Recurring Types and noted at Serial No. 05, FY 2020-21 in the Register of Grants placed in the NPIU Section.

4. The expenditure is debit to the Major Head MH-3601-Grants-In-Aid under the component GEN, SCPSC& TSP from the budget provision under Grant No.91-MSDE during FY 2021-22 as specified below:
