



NOTE

This has reference to various e-mails, tweets & messages being received on different accounts of Hon'ble Minister & other officials of MSDE & DGT. In this matter the following are clarified:

1. The All India Trade Test (AITT) for Craftsmen Training Scheme being implemented in ITIs for the session 2018-20 (second year for two years trade), 2019-20 (final exams for 1 year trade) and for 2019-21 (first year exams for 2 years trades) have been concluded in the 2nd / 3rd week of April, 2021. The exams were conducted for the trainees from the states which were mapped by the state directorates and participated in the examinations. The trainees who could not participate in the examinations may appear in the next examination along with the supplementary candidates that would be held preferably within two months from the declaration of the results. The Directorate General of Training (DGT), MSDE is in the process of finalizing the results and the same will be declared within a fortnight.
2. The examinations for failed trainees of erstwhile semester scheme will be held after consultations / agreeing of various state directorates depending upon the current pandemic situation. The notification for these examinations will be published separately.
3. The DGT has a clearly issued notes earlier regarding promoting the trainees from 1st year to 2nd year of 2 year trades subject to the examinations being held at a later stage and declaration of results thereafter.
