SCHEME OF KAUSHALACHARYA AWARDS

**GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

1.0 BACKGROUND

Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship launched the National Skill Development Mission (NSDM) in 2015 to provide a strong institutional framework to implement and scale up skill development efforts across the country through short-term and long-term training.

Directorate General of Training (DGT), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is entrusted with the responsibility of long-term vocational training in the Country. The long-term training is imparted through 15,042 Industrial Training Institutes (Govt. 2738 + Private 12,304 ITIs). Initiatives for improving quality of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) include, formulation of new affiliation norms, grading to evaluate their performance, ISO 29990 certification to raise the overall quality and standards, regular inspection of ITIs, regular up-gradation of training content of ITI curriculum as per industrial requirement etc.

Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship started “Kaushal Acharya Awards” for skill trainers for their outstanding contribution in creating a future-ready and skilled workforce.

2.0 OBJECTIVE

The purpose of the scheme is

- to identify young talented skill trainers who have established competence in their area of specialization;
- to recognize the contribution made by skill trainers;
- raising the prestige of skill trainers and
- to motivate more skill trainers to join the Skill India Mission.

3.0 CATEGORY AND NUMBER OF AWARDS

Number of awards for every State in engineering and non-engineering trades are given in Annexure-I. Apart from this, there will be three awards in each category namely; “Engineering Trades” and “Non-Engineering Trades”

4.0 ELIGIBILITY

- The scheme is open to regular skill trainers working in National Council for Vocational Education & Training (NCVET) approved Industrial Training Institutes and National Skill Training Institutes.
- Skill trainers with atleast 05 years regular teaching experience.

5.0 CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Criteria for selection of “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” are given at Annexure-II.

6.0 NOMINATIONS

Maximum number of nominations allowed from every State/UT are given in Annexure-III.

7.0 PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:

- The initial selection shall be made at the State level by a State Level Selection Committee from amongst the names recommended by the Principal/Director of the institute.
- The State Selection Committee shall scrutinize and recommend names for “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” to the Union Government. The final selection will be made by the Union Government.

8.0 COMPOSITION AND FUNCTION OF STATE LEVEL COMMITTEE

The composition of State Level Committee for selection of “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” are as follows:

Major functions to be performed by State Level Committee are as follows:

- (i) Verification of facts/information provided by Principal/Director in-charge of the Institute.
- (ii) Evaluate all the nominations as per criteria mentioned in Annexure-II
- (iii) Forward names of Skill Trainers in each category from each State/UT to National Level Committee, subject to the maximum number allotted to the States/UTs as per Annexure-III. Proforma for recommending the Skill Trainers for “Kaushalacharya” is given at Annexure-IV

9.0 COMPOSITION AND FUNCTION OF NATIONAL LEVEL COMMITTEE

The composition of National Level Committee for selection of “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” are as follows:

Major functions to be performed by National Level Committee are as follows:

- (i) Review the list of candidates as forwarded by State Level Committee and carry out fresh assessment.
- (ii) Selection of “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” from every State

10.0 TIMELINE

For selection of “KAUSHAL ACHARYA” for the year 2020, applications will be invited physically. From year 2021, applications for the award would be accepted through online portal. Portal-site will be designed soon. The link for registration would be provided. Timeline for submission of application, scrutiny of applications and forwarding list of shortlisted candidates by State Level Committee are given below:

- (i) Submission of application by the applicant : 15th May
- (ii) Scrutiny of applications by Principal/Director in-charge of Institute : 15th June
- (iii) Shortlisted of candidates by State Level Selection Committee : 15th July
- (iv) Forwarding list of shortlisted candidates by State Level Committee: 31st July
