Subject: Sanction for release of funds for expenditure for SPIU in Rajasthan under the Project "Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE)" with the World Bank assistance.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to incur an expenditure not exceeding **Rs. 43.86 Lakhs (Rupees Forty Three Lakhs and Eighty Six Thousand only)** towards 100% of Central Share on the component of State Project Implementation Unit (SPIU) in the State of **Rajasthan** for Implementation & Monitoring of envisaged activities as per the norms given in the Operational Manual under the Project "Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE)" with the World Bank assistance.

2. I am now directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of Central Share of **Rs. 43.86 Lakh (Rupees Forty Three Lakhs and Eighty Six Thousand only)** to meeting expenditure on **Salaries & Other expenditure for SPIU**, as indicated in the Operational Manual, as per break up given below.


3. The release of above mentioned Central fund in respect of the said scheme is subject to the guidelines mentioned in the Operational Manual, Procurement Section and Financial Management Section along with the following conditions:

- (i) The SPIU should be renovated / constructed in accordance with the NCVT approved space norms through National Competitive Bidding (NCB)/ Shopping Mode / Direct Contracting Mode as applicable under World Bank procurement procedure. While planning for the civil works for the SPIU, it should be ensured that recommendations indicated in Environment Management Framework are implemented
- (ii) The grant shall be utilized for the activities mentioned in the OM for SPIU and no portion of it shall be spent on any other purpose.
- (iii) The grant should be utilized before close of project STRIVE and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.

- (iv) The conditions mentioned under "Memorandum of Understanding" (MoU) should be adhered to during project implementation.
 - (v) It should be ensured that the agreed documents as per Disclosure Management Framework are disclosed on the website of SPIU/State Directorate.
 - (vi) All documents must be retained by the State Govt. for post review by the World Bank.
 - (vii) Utilization Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating expenditure incurred under the scheme should be furnished to DGT in Duplicate.
 - (viii) State Government must submit Quarterly expenditure information through Interim Unaudited Financial Report within 15 days of the close of each quarter to enable raise reimbursement claims by the Central Government from the World Bank as mentioned in Financial Management Manual.
 - (ix) Annual Audited Financial Statements of the project should be submitted within 4 months after the end of each fiscal year.
4. The expenditure is debitible to the Major Head "3601" during FY 2018-2019 for General components are as under:


